

Exciting New Canine Breeding Services!

We have some exciting news for our breeding clients - we have recently purchased a state-of-theart endoscope, liquid nitrogen tanks for semen storage and a phase microscope to allow us to perform frozen transcervical insemination advanced and semen assessment. As we already offer ovarian follicle scans, in-house progesterone testing and were performing substantial numbers of regular artificial inseminations, we decided to further expand our services to include TCI, so our breeders can now have frozen inseminations performed locally, rather than needing to travel. Tick Paralysis cases are starting already

Unfortunately, we have already seen several cases of tick paralysis in dogs and cats and it is only August. Many people believe tick paralysis only occurs in the warmer months of the year but in the Manning Valley we can see cases year-round, so please ensure your dog and cat are on an effective tick preventative. Tick preventatives literally save lives because sadly, not all pets who are treated for tick paralysis will survive so prevention truly is better than a cure. September is Dental Month!

Take advantage of our free dental checks this September.

The majority of pets have some degree of dental disease. The most common signs of dental disease as noticed by owners are bad breath, difficulty or pain when eating, an aversion to hard foods and sometimes, weight loss. These signs usually occur once the dental disease is severe with some teeth requiring extraction, which is why it is important that your pet's teeth are checked by your Veterinarian, as the signs of early and moderate dental disease can be subtle and are often not detected by owners. Once dental

disease progresses beyond grade 1, the damage to the tooth structures is permanent. Poor dental health is quite painful and can lead to high levels of bacteria in the blood stream that can damage the heart, liver and kidneys. The dog pictured above with Grade 4 disease would likely have severe difficulty eating and have chronic pain.
